

ABRACADABRA CUP STAKES



On October 25, 1998 the Greater Valley Forge Rhodesian Ridgeback Club held their first lure coursing trial. It was a Ridgeback only trial with several of the best coursing Ridgebacks in the country attending. The BOB ribbon that day went to a young bitch named ‘Lamington’s Abracadabra JC’ (Abby). Abby was running in only her second lure coursing trial and her first AKC trial. In gratitude to the Greater Valley Forge Rhodesian Ridgeback Club, and to the dog who gave them such thrill that day, Sue Ann and Clay Leslie have donated this trophy which they have named the “Abracadabra Cup”.

The Abracadabra Cup will be awarded annually at the fall GVFRRC trials. The Rhodesian Ridgeback who competes both days and defeats the most Rhodesian Ridgebacks during the weekend shall be awarded the trophy. In case of a tie, the Rhodesian Ridgeback with the highest cumulative score shall win, if necessary a runoff will determine the winner. The owner of the winning Rhodesian Ridgeback will be responsible for engraving their hound’s name on the trophy plate and returning the trophy to GVFRRC on or before the following fall GVFRRC AKC trials.
