Eligible Breeds and Registry

Only purebred Afghans, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizian Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Sloughis, Scottish Deerhounds, Whippets, Azawakh, Portuguese Podengo, Sloughi, and Thai Ridgebacks, one year of age or older and who are registered with the American Kennel Club or an AKC recognized foreign registry or have an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP), are eligible for an entry. Breed disqualifications apply.

Tests Offered

QUALIFIED COURSER: Open to hounds at least 12 months of age. A hound must run the course with a hound of its own breed or one of similar running style and must complete the entire course with enthusiasm and without interruption. The course is a minimum of 600 yards with a minimum of four (4) turns.
JUNIOR COURSER: Open to all eligible sighthounds at least 12 months of age. A hound running alone must receive a certification from a Judge on one date, and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, with each Judge stating that the hound completed a (minimum) 600-yard course with a minimum of 4 turns. The hound must complete the entire course with enthusiasm and without interruption. Ribbons (Dark Green) will be awarded to all hounds that successfully complete the AKC Junior Courser Test.

Stakes Offered

OPEN: Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title.
Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title are **NOT** eligible to enter the Open Stake.
OPEN VETERAN: Open to all hounds, which are eligible to enter either Open or Special Stake, and are of Veteran age as determined by their Parent Breed Club. Championship Points will be awarded and may count towards either Field Championship or LCX titles.
SPECIAL: Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. Championship points earned from this stake will count towards an LCX title. Qualifying scores earned from the Specials Stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title. Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered

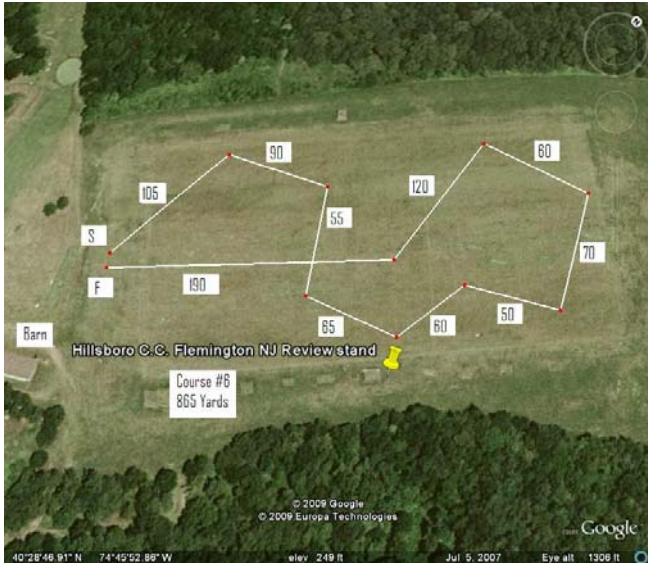
Best In Field (BIF): Will be Offered. (Italian Greyhounds ineligible).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at time of Roll Call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic bags or strips. Backup equipment will be available. The course will be reversed for the final courses. The members of GVFRRRC reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.

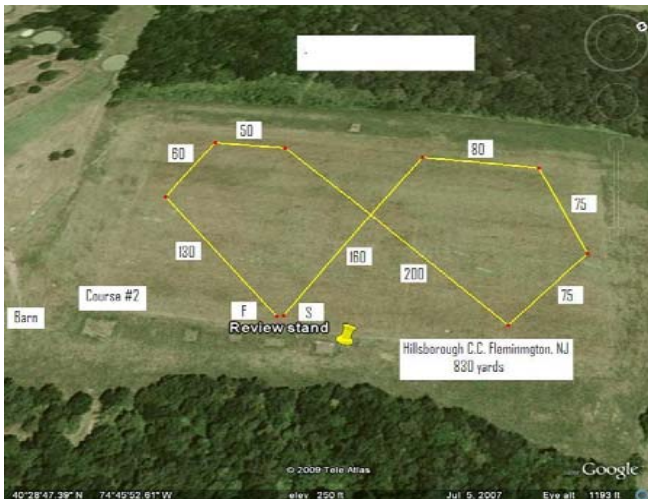

In case of a tie, the RR with the highest cumulative score shall win; if necessary a runoff will determine the winner. The owner of the winning RR will be responsible for engraving their hound's name on the plaque and returning the trophy to GVFRRC on or before the following spring GVFRRC AKC trials.
